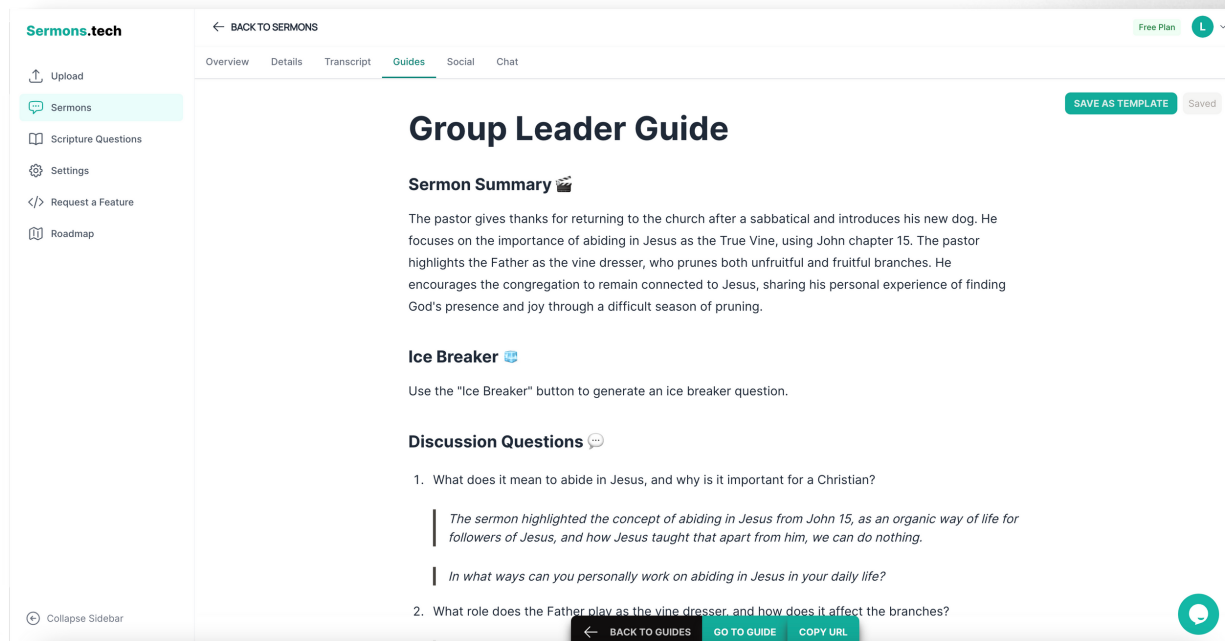

The Gospel of John: Abiding in the Vine | Pastor Lee Cummings

Scripture

John 15:1-11

Summary
